## Put God First

Do you think of God when you wake up, at meals, school, when playing, and before bed? If you think of God each day, you are putting God first!

## Bethelwoods Camp

Our church supports Bethelwoods Camp and Conference Center by giving money and praying for it. It is a great place to meet new friends, learn more about God and your faith, and have tons of fun in the summer. Day camp is available each week during the summer for children who have completed kindergarten through eighth grade (ages 5-13). Overnight camps, from a couple of days to an entire week, are available to those who have completed 1<sup>st</sup> grade and up.

## Help Other People

Remember the Golden Rule every day - "Treat others how you want to be treated". There are many ways for you to help such as giving dimes to help hungry people, bringing peanut butter and jelly for the Fort Mill Care Center the first Sunday of each month, selecting an Angel during Advent, and helping out on a work day to clean outside the church.
