We invite you to pray about and discuss with your parents how you will give to God's Kingdom here at Unity Presbyterian Church in the coming year.

Included in this mailing you'll find a form which has three sections:

- 1) Financial: It may feel overwhelming to commit to donating money, but could you commit to giving \$5 or \$10 each month? If you babysit, receive a birthday allowance, or work a job after school, consider even setting a small portion aside to glorify God.
- 2) Discipleship: How will you grow in your faith this year? Will you commit to attending Sunday School, youth group, trips and retreats, and more?
- 3) Service: There are countless ways to utilize your gifts and talents to serve in Unity's various ministries. How will you use your gifts to serve the church this year?
