ONE: He appeared to Mary, to Peter, and to the twelve, and to many faithful witnesses.

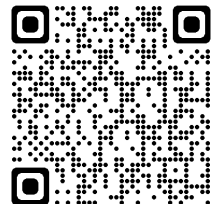
MANY: Alleluia! The Lord is risen indeed!
