ADULT GROUPS AT UNITY

Unity offers a variety of ongoing and short-term groups for fellowship, study and service. Listed below are some of those groups along with a short description. CIRCLE OF GRACE - GRANDMOTHERS PRAYER GATHERING

Grandmothers are invited to join the Circle of Grace, a warm and welcoming group dedicated to praying for our grandchildren. We gather out of love for them, hope for their future, and a desire to engage our faith through intentional prayer. This group meets on the last Thursday of every month at 10:00 a.m. in the Heritage Room. Come and share in this time of encouragement, fellowship, and prayer as we lift up the next generation.

CREATIVE EXPRESSIONS

Creative Expressions is an ongoing team that uses creative talents such as cross-stitch, crochet, knitting, beading Chrismons, quilting, etc. for our church and the community. This group provides an opportunity to connect with others at Unity.

GOD'S GIRLS BIBLE STUDY GROUP

This group meets weekly from August to May on Tuesday at 10:00 AM. We read and discuss books and use published Bible Studies that are read and have reflective questions to answer. Participants share facilitating the lessons throughout the year.

GRIEF AND LOSS SUPPORT GROUP

The Grief and Loss Support Group meets as needed. Participants will discuss the grief process and share experiences that can help comfort and reassure each other that they are not alone. Persons experiencing any form or phase of grief are encouraged to express interest.

LUNCH BUNCH

Lunch Bunch is a fellowship group for adults who are free at midday. This group meets monthly for lunch, fellowship, interesting programs, and an occasional trip or tour away from the church.

MEN'S MINISTRY GROUP

Men's Ministry invites participation by all men of Unity and their guests. Join this group if you are interested in attending our monthly breakfast meetings where we fellowship, enjoy a delicious breakfast prepared by volunteers, share a devotional and plan participation in service projects.

MESSY MOTHERHOOD

This group is open to moms with young children. We currently have two small groups who meet on Zoom one evening a week from 7:30-8:30 p.m. for 6 weeks at a time throughout the year to read and discuss a book. Recent topics have included Bible Study, Sharing Faith with Children, Prayer, and Spiritual Practices. At the end of each study, we meet at a local restaurant for a Dutch treat meal and fellowship.

PRAYER SQUARE TEAM

This team knits or crochets prayer squares that are available to be shared with those in need.
